

## **Proceedings of 14<sup>th</sup> District Level Research-Extension Linkage of Sundargarh District**

The 14<sup>th</sup> District Level Research-Extension Interface meeting of Sundargarh district was conducted under the Chairmanship of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Sundargarh-I at 03:00 PM on dt.21.08.2018 in Conference Hall of KVK, Sundargarh. At the outset the Senior Scientist and Head, KVK Sundargarh-I welcomed the members and highlighted the action taken on recommendations of previous meeting and ongoing activities.

### **The highlights of the meeting as per Annexure-I (Agenda):**

<b>SI No</b>	<b>Recommendation of last meeting</b>	<b>Action Taken on Previous Meeting</b>
1	Millets to be demonstrated in the crop cafeteria of KVK	Demonstration of Millets namely foxtail millet (Kango), little millet (OLM 217 & 203) and ragi (Jaguli & Bhairabi) have been undertaken in crop cafeteria B of Instructional Farm.
2	Floriculture to be developed in adopted villages	4 SHGs in KVK adopted villages have been identified for floriculture.
3	Development of few farm entrepreneurs of the district to establish IFS Models.	Sri Kautuk Das, Farmer, Jhargaon, Lephripara was identified for development of his IFS and invited to share his details.

### **The highlights of the meeting:**

1. Koutak Dash, Farmer, Lephripara :-Informed the house of his background in IAF and post-retirement has started one IFS unit including Fish, Animal, Agri and Horticulture components. Expressed his interest in floriculture and the marketing of the produce.
2. ADH :- Informed the house as per KVK recommendations on the previously conducted OFT and FLD on kharif onion, this year onion c.vAFDR is being distributed to farmers for the first time in the district. He also informed on the support of his Dept towards Post harvest management, micro irrigation, mulching, zero energy cool chamber, etc for production and marketing. Regarding onion storage he described a 25 MT onion storage structure can be built by a farmer with a minimum expenditure Rs 87,000/- (Farmer cost) including subsidy by NHB, and urged other members to identify farmers and process their applications to the respective AHOs.
3. DDM NABARD :- Elaborately explained potential Linked Credit Plan and had invited one CEO of FPO of Lephripara Block and he shared the experience in marketing of drumstick, tomato, chilli, pointed gourd, etc and urged the house to encourage formation of FPOs for marketing and post-harvest management activities.
4. CEO, FPO Sri Gangadhar Kisan, elaborately explained his FPO activity in marketing of products, he also informed the house about the working of the FPOs and the cluster areas wherein a particular crop is identified for its production and handholding in terms of inputs crop production, management, etc are provided to the farmers and

marketing is done by the farmers. He also elaborated the recent purchase of drip irrigation equipments, sprinklers, etc, for irrigation made by tribal farmers initiated by NABARD.

5. FMU Coordinator (Forest Dept.) : Informed of 10,000 saplings of fruit and forest species distributed during this season along with Nutritional Gardening in 28 villages.
6. Rep. of NGO SEWAK : Informed the house about water stress during the transplanting stage and SRI paddy was only confined to those places having stream in their working area in around 4 watersheds. The ongoing plantation of mango, cashew through MGNREGA was in full swing due to late onset of monsoon.
7. Rep of SS&H-II , Scientist (PP) informed on the FPOs identified in KVK Sundargarh2 and the support through convergence with diff line dept on the dissemination of technology.
8. OIC & Senior Scientist, RRTTSS, Kirei ; informed the house of normal rainfall in the ensuing week and suggested measures to drain excess water from existing fields.
9. SS&H, Sundargarh-1 : FPO to be created in KVK villages - Development and identification of commodity-wise farmer producers groups in each KVK Villages and subsequently developing them into FPOs. Preparation of standard chart on nutritional garden and display of such chart in all villages. All line department to stay focussed on the DFI farmers of K.V.K and provide extra support to them.
10. Discussion were also made on development of few farm entrepreneurs of the district to establish IFS Models and to document the different existing IFS in the district as demanded by ICAR.
11. It was finally decided to focus and promote on nutritional garden development in maximum villages of the district with support of all the line department.
12. It was decided to make a joint visit to the existing FPO in the district and to document their activities.


