

## Proceedings of 2<sup>nd</sup> District Level Research-Extension Interface of KVK, Sundargarh-I

The 2<sup>nd</sup> District Level Research-Extension Interface was conducted under the Chairmanship of Sri Kedarnath Mohapatra, Project Director, ATMA-cum-Deputy Director of Agriculture, Sundargarh at 3:00 PM on dt.19.07.2016 in KVK, Kirei premises. The Senior Scientist and Head, KVK Sundargarh-II welcomed the members. He also elaborately explained the objectives of the meeting and read out the letter of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, OUAT, Bhubaneswar and DPME, OUAT on the importance of conducting such programme to strengthen the Research- Extension Linkage at the District Level.

SS&H, KVK, Sundargarh1 appraised the house regarding the action taken on the last meeting suggestion & recommendations and informed the house

3.	Sri Surendra Patel suggested to include some of the pre and post emergence herbicides in major crops.	Post-emergence herbicide <i>Bispyribac sodium</i> & <i>Londax Power</i> in paddy has already been started in villages of salepali, mahulpali, khamarbahal
4.	To increase the income of the animal resource farmer infusion of better germplasm suitable like Barbari, Jamunapari and Betal in goat.	Baseline survey of village Karanjkhoh, GP - Gundiadihi & Udurma-GP-Tarkera has been completed under TSP village programme & improved bucks will be introduced in the village after complete vaccination of the livestock.
5.	Diary farming is an important part of tribal culture and skill and knowledge training to be imparted to rural youths in modern dairying.	As per the modular action plan two farmers have been identified Uduruma village of Tarkera GP & training will be imparted next month
6.	Farmers suggested for trials on black variety of sesamum.	Sesamum seeds of black variety are to be procured from AICRPO (Sesamum ) for conducting the trial to be started from next month.

he also appraised the house regarding implementation of agro-ecological situation based module to double the income of farmers in this regard he informed the house that beneficiaries in the villages have been selected and critical inputs will be distributed by july.

In house discussion was started and PD, Watersheds, Sundargarh informed the house regarding the plantation programme taken up in different watersheds with intercropping of pulses oilseeds and vegetables and requested for training support to the farmers in these watersheds. He also expressed his concern for non-availability of pulse seeds and requested

DDA, Sundargarh for needful help. Dist. Fishery Officer, informed the house regarding ongoing programmes of his Dept. which includes awareness camp combining fishery activity and dengue control has been launched in convergence with Health Dept. He also informed that 59 SC/ST beneficiaries have been given fishing rights on river Brahmani at Deodhar in Gurundia block the beneficiaries will be provided with fishing nets and boats in due course of time. He also enquired about KVK CIFA, collaborated efforts under TSP programme to provide FRP Carp Hatchery to two progressive tribal farmers in Bonai and Rajgangpur Block and in reply, SS&H Sundargarh I told that the farmers will be visiting ABI Unit of CIFA for exposure during their training programme. ADVO representing CDVO, Sundargarh informed the house that sufficient vanraja poultry chicks and bucks can be made available to KVK through Govt. institutions for programme under Animal Husbandry component. He also suggested testing / experiments to study residual toxicity upon livestock by the herbicides applied on different crops. Scientist (Agronomy) KVK Sundargarh made a brief presentation of different herbicides applied in paddy on request of DDH, Sundargarh. Sr Scientist and OIC, RRTTSS, Kirei appraised the house regarding the trials on Maize with different intercrops being undertaken at Kirei campus, he also informed the house regarding weather forecast bulletin and advisories sent each week on Tuesday and Fridays. The Chairman (PD, ATMA cum DDA, Sundargarh) informed the house regarding funds available under ATMA for training and demonstration especially in A&H Component and suggested the ADVO to organize different animal husbandry activities in all blocks and utilize the fund. He requested to inform all farmers regarding availability of enrollment form of PMFBY with AAOs of the respective blocks and encourage the farmers to enroll. The required documents for the purpose are voter ID, copy of bank passbook and sowing certificate issued by the AAO is sufficient to cover the farmers under PMFBY. He also requested KVKs to provide different scientific messages each week to ATMA for sending to farmers through m-kisan portal of DDA. The next date of meeting was fixed on 16<sup>th</sup> August 2016

The meeting ended at 6.30 PM with vote of thanks by Satyamaya Satapathy, Scientist Agronomy, K.V.K, Kirei to the Chair and all members.
