

Proceedings of 5th District Level Research-Extension Interface of Sundargarh District

The 5th District Level Research-Extension Interface was conducted under the Chairmanship of Sri Rabinarayan Satapathy, Project Director, ATMA-cum-Deputy Director of Agriculture, Sundargarh at 11:00 AM on dt.18.10.2016 in Conference Hall of KVK, Kirei, Sundargarh. The Senior Scientist and Head, KVK Sundargarh-II welcomed the members. He also elaborately explained the objectives of the meeting on the importance of conducting such programme to strengthen the Research- Extension Linkage at the District Level and read out the letter of Dean, Extension Education dt 16.9.2016 regarding putting up inventory of technology for vetting.

He appraised the house regarding the action taken on the last four meetings, suggestion & recommendations, he also appraised the house regarding implementation of agro-ecological situation based module to double the income of farmers in this regard he informed the house that cowpea seeds and mushroom spawn has already been provided and FLD on sweet corn cultivation and nursery raising techniques has been done. The SS&H, Kirei apprised the house regarding the ongoing field activities and informed the house of the 5 OFT and 6 FLD presently continuing in the ensuing season and the interventions in the module based programmes for increasing the income of farmers by 2022. He also appraised the house regarding the proposed activities under the tribal focused programme under TSP and the infrastructure proposed under different activities in NTFP collection and value addition, community rearing and brooding of backyard poultry for increasing family income. The following actions were taken as per the recommendations of the previous interface.

Action points	Action Taken
Popularizing Organic farming, to make a village totally organic :	In consultation with NGO, CIRTD, village Brahmanmara, Balisankara block has been selected for organic farming of vegetables, oilseeds, pulses, cereals and other crops. A crop cafeteria in the instructional farm of KVK, Kirei has been identified for organic cultivation of vegetables in the ensuing kharif
Popularization of vaccination in poultry :	Already included in training to tribal farmers

Action points	Action Taken
birds among tribals.	under TSP programme about vaccination schedules from day old chicks to 3months poultry
Popularization of vaccination in cattle and livestock :	Awareness programmms including animal health camps are being conducted in TSP adopted villages.
Popularization of System of Mustard and Intensification among farmers :	OFT on SMI has already been included and sowing is under progress in operational villages of KVK.

Continuing the in house discussion Mr Dayanidhi Raut, ADH, Sundargarh addressed the farmers with prospects and scope of horticultural crops in this district. He stressed upon cultivation mango, banana, cashew and vegetables and asked the farmers to take different benefits from NHM schemes and be in close touch with Horticultural department. He apprised the house regarding Govt. schemes operating in his department and ongoing programmes.

Mr S Kalo, Dist Fishery Officer, Sundargarh apprised the house and the farmers regarding different commercial ventures in fishery sector and different infrastructure development assistance provided by his department like digging up of new pond and desilting of old ponds through MGNREGA. He also informed the house that the estimated cost for digging of 1ha pond is increased to Rs. 8.5 lakhs where 50% subsidy is available. He advised the farmers to contact the block level fishery officers and route their applications for quick disposal of their cases.

Sri Sanat Naik, DPD, Watersheds informed the house regarding PMKSY and other livelihood activities in watershed areas.

Dr KB Sahoo, ADVO, Sundargarh in his address stressed upon the cause and effect of japaneese encephalitis virus and its prophylaxis which primarily transmitted from pigs to human beings and advised for vaccination of the children below 15 years and requested not to panic. He requested the farmers to cooperate with the vety dept for mass vaccination of cattle and livestock, he also informed the house regarding availability of different vaccines in plenty with his dept. Supplementing him Dr. D Parida AVAS, Tangarpalli informed the farmers regarding the ongoing schemes of the dept and how to avail them in relation to goatery, diary and poultry.

Mr. R Satapathy, DDA, Sundargarh in his address stressed on the use of organic inputs and use ITKs in cultivation practices. He interacted with RAWE students and
