Up scaling/ Out Scaling	(a) Paddy straw mushroom production increased from 200 beds in 2019-20 to 12,000 beds in 2023-24 in cluster (Group approach) Oyster mushroom production increased from 100 bags in 2019-20 to 5000 bags in 2023-24 in cluster (Group approach) (b) The entire Phuldhudi village comprising of 7 SHG groups have started mushroom production commercially round the year. (c) The Om Namah Sibaya SHG is the master trainer for Mushroom production and have trained over 400 women farmers of the district. (d) In total women farmers of 10 blocks of Sundargarh district have already visited the mushroom production unit at Phuldhudi village. (e) The convergence activities of all line departments of the district are being undertaken	

	in the KVK adopted village Phuldhudi. Total (19) mushroom houses from Horticulture Dept., 35 nos of vermin-bed have been provided (loan from Forest Dept.) (f) The Om Namah Sibaya SHG have also started production of Vermicompost (60ton) & procured by forest deptt. (g) After KVK intervention every members of the group have nutri-garden and quality vegetable seedling production in poly-tunnel in their backyard. (h) Collector & District Magistrate, CDO-cum-EO, Zilla parishad, Sundargarh, Divisional Forest Officer along with all heads of district line departments, Dr. K.K Sahoo, DDE, DEE, OUAT had visited the Phuldhudi village and appreciated the women entrepreneurial activities.
